- Aiding Animals is a student-led club coming to the University of Oklahoma campus.
- Aiding Animal's mission is to create a campus organization that is centered around philanthropy that serves the community's homeless animals.
- Service offered to local animal shelters includes walking animals, feeding them, offering help towards shelter staff, and much more that is subject to change.
- There are approximately 251 animals taken in at the Norman Animal Welfare center per month. The club's goal is to lower the number of animals in the shelter by 25% by the end of 2023 through education, volunteering, and fundraising in the community.

- The news was announced by club founder and president, Madison Snow. Snow founded Aiding Animals in Norman, OK in 2021.
- Club registration as a member and potential leader is open to any person who is currently enrolled as a student at the University of Oklahoma.
